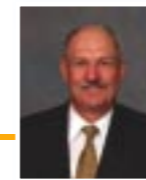

The gaming machine tax is only one of the many changes facing the Club Industry. New regulations in respect of corporate governance are being introduced and our Club's Chief Executive, Denis Fitzgerald, has been invited with nine other Club CEO's from across the State to be a part of a Ministerial Advisory Group formed by the Minister for Gaming & Racing, The Hon. Grant McBride, to provide advice on these changes from the Clubs' operational viewpoint.

I hope you enjoy reading about the promotions and entertainment planned for the next few months and I encourage you to visit the Club soon so that you can be a part of the excitement.

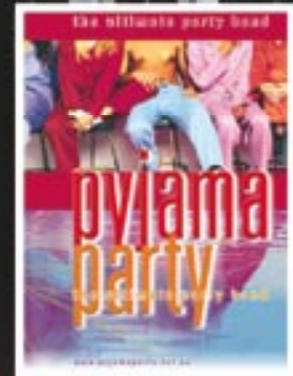

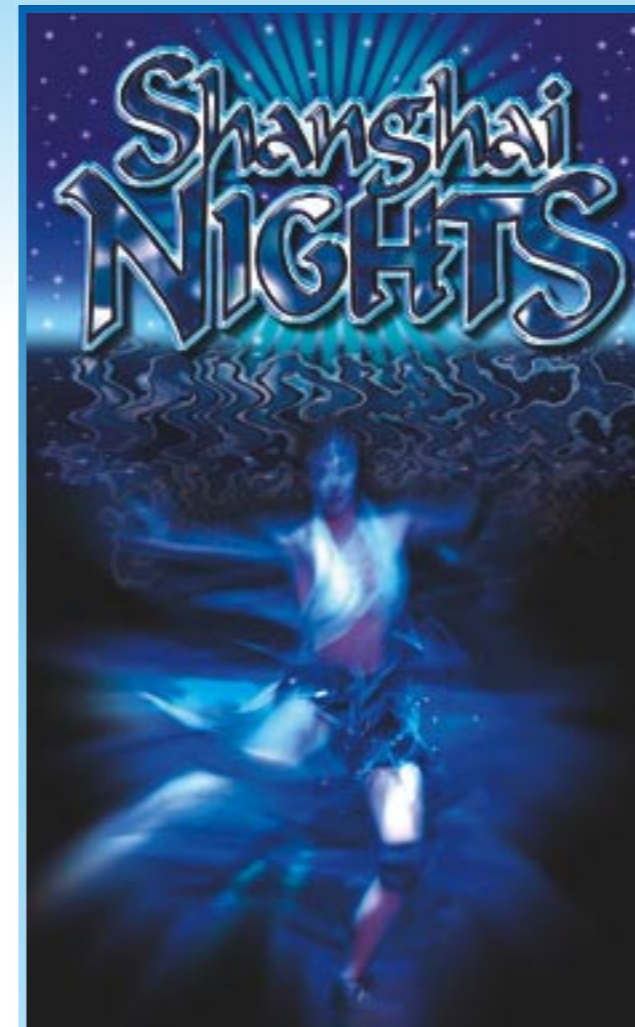
