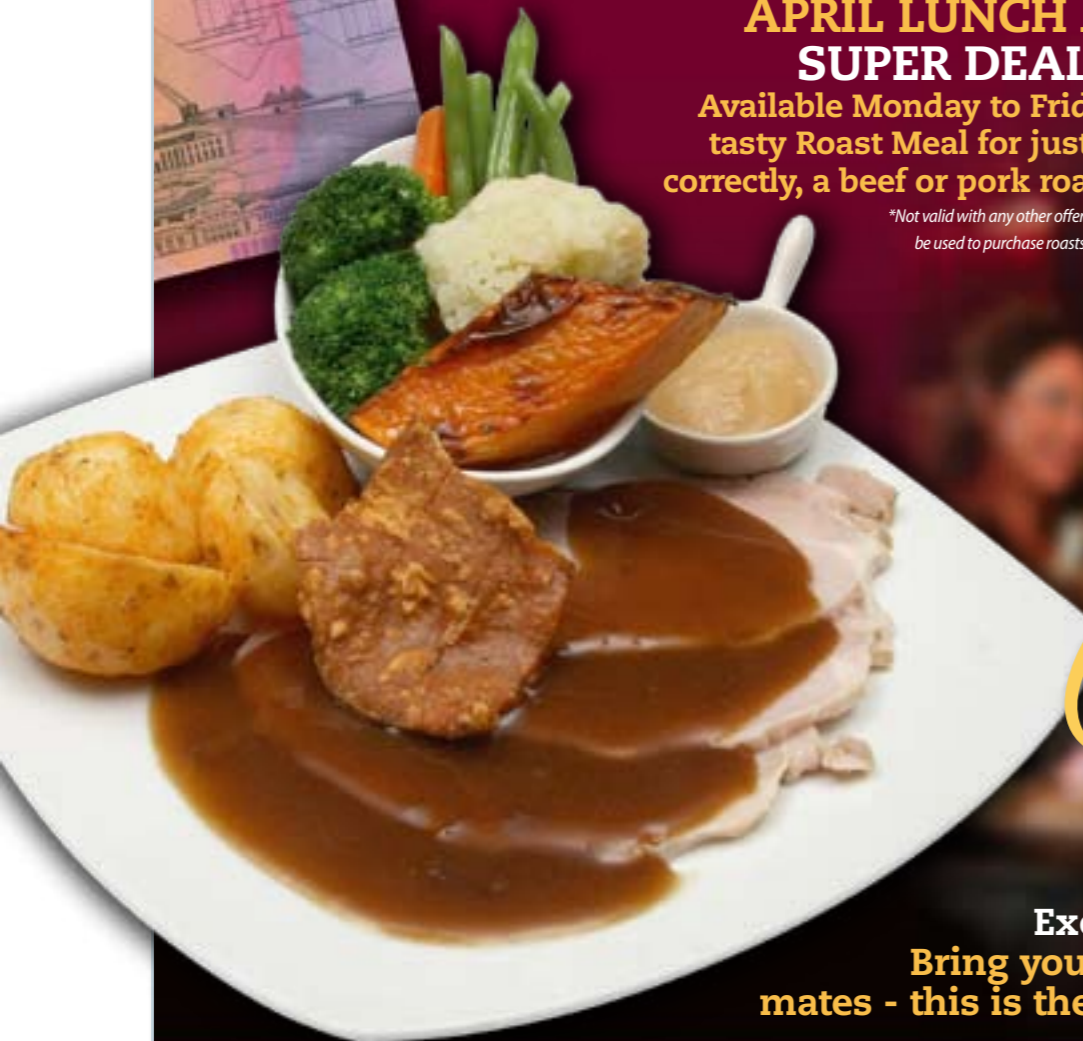

The Parramatta Water Polo Club would like to again thank Parramatta Leagues for the sponsorships it has provided to our Club. Without the sponsorship money the Water Polo Club would struggle to maintain its junior programs at the same level.



The sponsorship money continues to be used towards junior development in the Parramatta area. There is under 14s and under 16s teams competing in the Sydney water polo competition. The money is used for a variety of purposes, for the junior players such as:

1. Purchase of necessary equipment such as balls and caps
2. Player registration fees
3. Team entry fees
4. Club championship carnivals
5. Sponsorship money for juniors in representative teams
6. Advertising for players in local newspapers
7. Junior presentation day and awards
8. Club uniform
9. Club website licence fee

The average yearly costs to run the junior teams is approximately \$5,000 and the Parra Leagues grant covers 60% of our Club's expenses. As a result the Water Polo Club has been able to heavily subsidise the registration fee that juniors could have been charged.

The 2008-9 season was quite successful with the u14s boys team reaching the Metropolitan Competition Grand Final. Two players were selected in junior state teams and one of them also won a sports person award from Fairfield Council. Three boys were also selected for the U13s NSW development squad.

The Club's aim is to attract and develop as many juniors (girls and boys) in the area that are interested in playing water polo. All juniors over 10 years of age are welcome to play. If they are not quite ready for competition they are encouraged to train with the other juniors until they have developed their skills.

Parramatta Leagues Club donated over \$9,000 to the Parramatta Holroyd Family Support Inc. This grant was used to create and develop the 'Healthy Hearts Children Cooking Program'.

The program's aim is to encourage children to participate in cooking with nutritious food and learn about the different food groups as well as encouraging them to try different foods. The program was also developed to raise awareness about why we eat healthy food. The group also aimed to build self esteem and confidence in children through cooking and also through team fitness activities.

Children were given the opportunity to create different healthy meals and goodies based on the weekly theme. The children were very excited about sharing what they had made with their families as well as trying the different foods during group time. They also participated in different physical activities such as team tag, ball games, hoola hoop and skipping games.

The children have gained so much enjoyment, knowledge and self esteem from the group. Every week they improved a little each time.

The program will be run a further 3 times over the course of the year and up to 10 children will be able to attend each group. Overall this will allow up to 40 children to benefit from the program over the year and go towards educating those children of the importance of healthy food and exercise as well as building confidence and self esteem.

## Northcott's New Ride

The Variety Club Sunshine Coach, a 22 seater Mitsubishi Rosa, has been modified to transport seven wheelchairs at one time, which also allows nine other people on the bus.

Kerry Stubbs, CEO of Northcott Disability Services said the not-for-profit organisation provided a number of services in and around the metropolitan Sydney region that requires transporting children and young adults with disabilities.

"The new bus will be used across a number of different services including Northcott's centre-based respite, recreation programs, community participation program and play groups," Ms. Stubbs said.

"These activities and outings assist in developing our client's independence and social confidence," she said.

"The bus replaces an old bus which did not have air conditioning, fewer built-in safety features, no tinted windows and less capacity, meaning more clients will now not only be able to attend outings within the community, but be able to travel in comfort," she said. Ms Stubbs said Northcott relies on financial support from the community to continue to provide services and activities for the 8,000 clients and families it supports.

"I am delighted by the efforts of Variety the children's charity NSW, Sargents Pies Charitable Foundation and the Parramatta Leagues Club in collectively providing us with this much-needed bus," Ms. Stubbs said.

"Because of their generous and continued support Northcott will be able to continue to fulfil our commitment to our clients and their families in Metropolitan Sydney," she said.

Tullio Cofrancesco, Chief Executive of the Parramatta Leagues Club said: "Parramatta Leagues Club has a long and proud association with Northcott Disability Services."

"When we received the proposal to sponsor the new bus, we immediately saw how beneficial it would be to the services provided by Northcott," Mr. Cofrancesco said.

"We are honoured to be a part of such an important community project," he said.

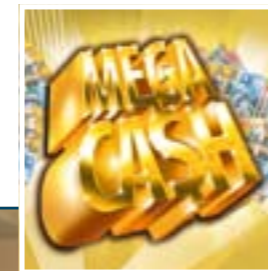
## Mega Cash gives Gary 28,000 reasons to celebrate

## Blast From The Past David Penna

There are certain rugby league players that are remembered for unusual reasons after they hang up the boots. Despite their achievements on the field, some simply cannot shake the famous or controversial moments they were involved in during their playing days. Former Crushers hard man Mario Fenech is remembered for a stray pass causing the ball to hit him in the head, now colloquially referred to as a 'falcon'. Martin Bella is the brunt of several jokes for playing the ball in the wrong direction during an Origin game for Queensland, and who could ever forget Terry Lamb kicking a last minute field goal for Canterbury despite his team being down by two points.

Former Eels halfback David Penna has his own unique, if perhaps unwanted place in this quirky group. He was the player who not once but twice broke his neck in the one season during Parramatta's 2000 NRL campaign. It was a cruel and career ending blow to a player who at the time was displaying the consistent form that had him leading around the likes of Jason Smith and Jim Dymock as the Eels' chief playmaker. But the skills that he couldn't keep reproducing on the field soon transferred through his ability to pass on his knowledge to the game's up and comers.

"I have been involved in a fair bit of coaching since I retired, especially in the last five years or so, and I'm currently the Toyota Cup Head Coach at Manly. I really love the coaching side of things, it's great to have input with younger players in the game. Rugby league is a great sport and it has helped me get to where I am and I'm really appreciative of that."

Penna was a rugged and skilful player during his career, which began at Parramatta in 1990 where he was primarily used as an outside back. In 1994 he moved to South Sydney where he spent four seasons before returning to the Eels where he shifted into the halves. He cracked his fourth cervical vertical vertebrae in round three of the 2000 season after a collision against Cronulla and spent the next three months undergoing rehab before making his return later in the season. The second break, which ironically was also against Cronulla, was one that he could not overcome and lead to his premature retirement from playing at the age of 27 on advice from medical experts.

"It was obviously not the happiest ending, I didn't achieve all I wanted to as a player but sometimes that's the way it goes," he says philosophically. "But it's not as though I can really complain, I had a chance to play with some of the players I loved to watch when I was growing up and played over a hundred first grade games which not a lot of guys get to do."



Nowadays Penna's full time job is at Radio 2GB as an Account Manager and he has had a high level of involvement with the radio advertising carried out by Parra Leagues in recent times. It has been a good result for the man who was always determined to make his mark in the media. Despite his coaching link with Manly, he still closely monitors the team that he followed and loved when he was a child.

"I keep a close eye on the Eels of course. They set a great standard last year, which means teams will want to play their best every time they play Parramatta. If they can overcome that there is no reason why they won't be successful again."

David's Manly side clash with the Eels at Brookvale Oval in Round 10 in the curtain raiser to the first grade match. "These teams have always had a great rivalry so it will be a cracking match, I can promise you that!" He says with a smile. It's good to see his sense of humour was never damaged.



## Mortimer Stays an Eel

The Pirtek Parramatta Eels received a massive boost on the eve of the 2010 NRL season, with five-eighth Daniel Mortimer committing to the Club for the next two years, with an option for a third.

Mortimer has reaffirmed his commitment to the Eels, ending speculation about the 20 year old's future after strong interest from rival NRL Clubs, in a show of support for the Club which first signed him as a schoolboy.

The new contract will keep Mortimer at Parramatta until the end of 2012, with the third-year option possibly keeping the Orange CYMS junior at the Club until 2013.

Pirtek Parramatta Eels CEO Paul Osborne believes Mortimer's decision indicates the strength of the Parramatta Eels Club in 2010. "This is terrific news for the Club and it is an acknowledgement of the direction we're going in," Osborne said. "I think Daniel will be among some of the great players to have been at this Club due to his attitude off the field, as well as on. To keep Daniel at the Club has been the best possible start to the year we could hope for."

"He has a wonderful family, is a terrific bloke, a great player and it's a huge boost to lock him down for possibly the next three years."

Coach Daniel Anderson is ecstatic to hold onto the 20 year old Orange product, who will provide stability in the Eels' halves. "This is not only a huge boost for the team to have a player with Daniel's talent remain at Parramatta, but for the Club to hold onto a person of the calibre of Daniel is just as important," he said.

"He is an integral part of this team and Club, and at such a young age there is a lot of growth left in him. We will see even more of Daniel's ability in the next two years and that is exciting for us as a Club, and no doubt for the members and fans who will watch him every week."

Mortimer played 18 games in his debut season for the Parramatta Eels last year, scoring 10 tries.

Eels new boy Justin Poore is a rugby league professional who oozes enthusiasm... and commitment. He has a smile that beams cheekiness but a steely resolve in his eyes. Beneath both is a depth of character that Parra fans can count on in 2010.

**Leading  
 From the Back**

There is no doubt that Jarryd Hayne has superstar status in Sydney. The Eels' flyer has become a household name due to his on field performances that have established him as one of the finest players in the game. But in one girl's mind, he's a hero for what he has done off the field, which is a major turnaround for the 22 year old fullback.

Jarryd Hayne kindly donated his boots that he wore in the NRL All Stars game to Aimee Bliss, a young girl from the Central Coast, who has endured a horror year battling cancer and now she and Hayne want to give something back. They were the most talked about boots in Australia following the NRL All Stars game, Phil Gould described them as the "brightest boots I've ever seen" and Jarryd Hayne's yellow boots have been put to an even better cause.

The Daily Telegraph auctioned Jarryd Hayne's yellow boots, with all proceeds going to the Leukaemia Foundation, and the final bidder was 2GB's Ray Hadley, kindly donating \$5,000 to support Jarryd, Aimee and the Leukaemia Foundation.

Hayne is the first to admit that he had some growing up to do after the off field events that took place in 2008, but it was a turning point that the NSW and Australian rep has learnt from, and used to his own benefit.

"I now really see myself as a leader on and off the field, the boys look to me on the field and when I'm not playing it's great to help the community in any way that I can".

Only a couple of months ago he also took time out on his birthday to visit Frank Baxter Juvenile Justice Centre to spend time with the youth inside the facility, who were chuffed at having the chance to spend the afternoon with one of their sporting heroes, and show some of their own talents in the process.

"When I played for Fiji in the 2008 World Cup things began to change for me, I learnt a lot about respecting the game, and appreciating what I've got and that I shouldn't waste my opportunity to succeed in footy. We only have a short amount of time at the top of our game, so I don't want to let that slip by and look back with any regrets."

There is a lot of expectation on Hayne's shoulders heading into the 2010 season. In 2009 he was voted the game's best player, played all three State of Origin games, reclaimed his Australian jersey and led the Eels to a grand final berth after they were languishing near the bottom of the ladder. But as far as he sees it the job hasn't been done yet.

"Sure, last year was great for us with the roll on we had and to win so many games at the back end, but really, when you look at it we didn't win anything, and therefore we didn't achieve anything, that's what will be driving us this year, we want to turn all that hard work into a premiership."

A relationship struck with Eels CEO Paul Osborne during a humanitarian visit to Rwanda in 2008 was a catalyst for the career change for the 26 year old Poore after he established himself as a high quality representative front-rower in 2009. Osborne says of the NRL players he had taken to the African nation in the past two years, Poore was the most touched - enough for him to organise his own fund-raiser in Wollongong upon his return and go back for Osborne's second mission - helping build facilities in a village for dislocated people - last October.

The articulate Helensburg junior is also a qualified fitness instructor, having started his own business in 2008. He possesses a Master Trainer Certificates 3 and 4 plus his Level 1 Sports Trainers Certificate and has plans to make a career out of the field when his football days are completed.

There is a lot to achieve before that. Poore wouldn't have left the St George Illawarra Dragons, his rugby league home of six years, unless he could see success, and satisfaction, at Parramatta.

After having to drop out of 2008 World Cup calculations because of injury, he debuted for NSW Country last year and performed well enough to win his first NSW Blues jersey, ironically the same night his fellow Dragons prop and great mate Michael Weyman also debuted.

Poore played all three matches (Weyman the first two) and became a player in demand. But after being a part of the Dragons side that were minor premiers but lost both finals games, the first against the Eels 25-12 and to the Broncos 24-10, then missing selection in the Australian Quad Nations side, he wears the blue and gold jersey knowing he has much to play for.

"I'm determined to play a leading role at Parramatta in what is a very good, very powerful pack," says Poore. "I know my role is to be aggressive and be a player the other guys look to and can rely on. I take the fact that I'm a senior player and an Origin player now very seriously. I know we have a great team at Parra and the Club is just tremendous; I've been made so welcome."

It was ironic that Poore had to confront the Dragons in his NRL debut for the Eels, meaning he had an eyeball to eyeball duel with his close mate Weyman. He tried to stay out of the limelight for the week preceding the game and he and Weyman had little contact but there was no room for friendship when they locked horns. And neither expected anything different. However, there was some banter played out. Poore commented to team-mate Tim Mannah when being interviewed for the Eels website that, "He's still catching up on his extras because he's still a bit unfit"

"I couldn't believe my luck picking that as my first game but I knew I couldn't get overawed by the occasion. I really felt relaxed all week," Poore said. "I'm very excited to be here although it's very different to what I'm used to, especially the summer when we trained! I grew up on the beach on the south coast and it's very different in the west with the 40 degree-heat nearly every day."

"But I'm thoroughly enjoying it; I never met a better bunch of blokes in my whole life. I actually feel like I've been here for a lot longer than I have. The boys have made me feel really comfortable and I really love coming to training. It's good for me and it's a testament to the Club for a new player to be able to say that."

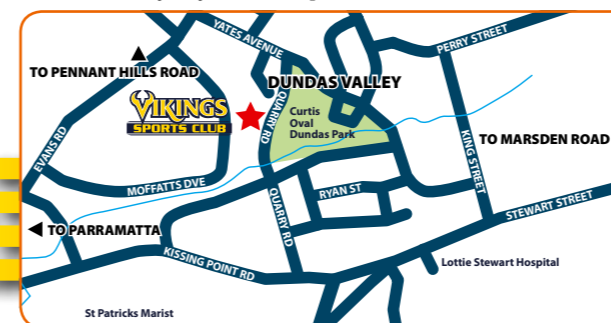

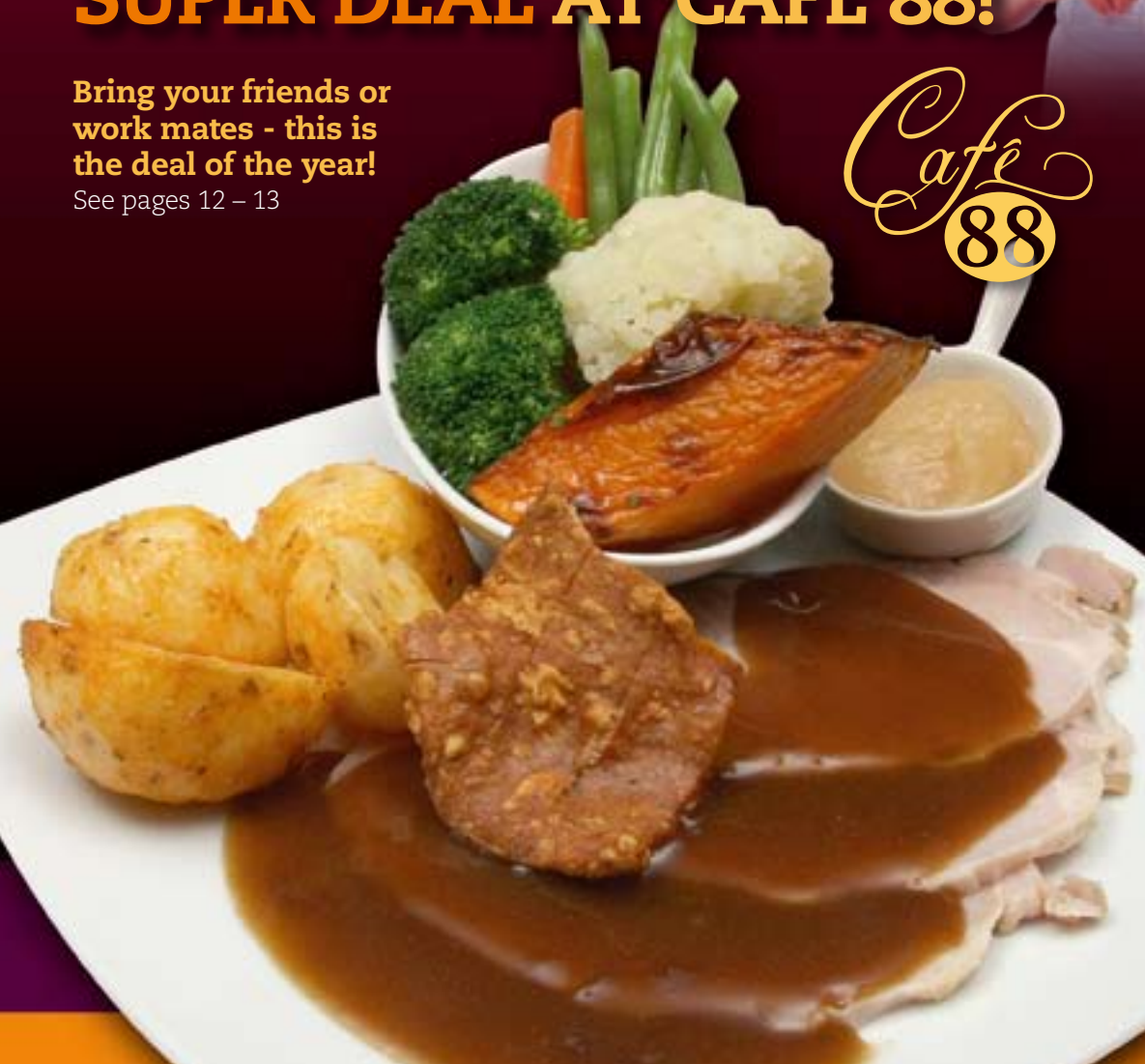
